Overview: Dream Catchers at the Cori Sikich Therapeutic Riding Center is a 501(c)(3) charitable organization established in 1993. Dream Catchers improves the quality of life for individuals with physical, emotional and developmental needs by providing evidence-based therapeutic riding, equine assisted activities and advancing effective practices through professional education and research. Dream Catchers serves approximately 4,000 participants (ages 4 through seniors in their 90's) each year with a team of 12 horses, 7 instructors, 1 Licensed Clinical Social Worker, 1 Licensed Professional Counselor, and 1 Licensed Speech Therapist. Dedicated volunteers support the programs with more than 17,500 volunteer hours annually. Dream Catchers is accredited as a Premier Center by the Professional Association of Therapeutic Horsemanship International (PATH INTL). annual operating budget exceeds \$750,000 and we fundraise 75% of this revenue. Dream Catchers has a highly engaged and influential Board of Directors. We have a strong marketing presence and receive very favorable press for our programs and our service to the region. We have been featured in the VA Gazette, the Daily Press, WYDAILY, The Richmond Times-Dispatch, The Health Journal and Inside Business numerous times and our programs have been spotlighted on National Public Radio.

Event: Cowboys Uncorked is an annual fundraiser held at the Williamsburg Winery for 275 guests, which is hosted by and which benefits Dream Catchers at the Cori Sikich Therapeutic Riding Center. Wessex Hall at the Winery is transformed into a western town – complete with a DJ, country line dancing lessons, western whiskey bar, jail house, gunslinger quick draw contest, games and more! The "celebrity arrestees" participating in the event are "bailed" out of the western jailhouse with donations to Dream Catchers. It is rodeo themed with cowboy fare (bar-b-que, brisket, chili, beer, wine, whiskey and sarsaparilla). Wear your boots & jeans and leave the heels & wingtips at home!
